## **ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- Conduct Fast Tracking Player Evaluations for members looking to play up within H&DSA including on site player evaluations as per Ontario Soccer rules and regulations.
- Support and manage the U8 Festival Program run directly by the District and the Coaching Development Manager with an immediate emphasis in week to week onsite support of the festival program.
- Assist existing and future player clinics run by recreational and youth leagues with in the district.
- Develop, support and deliver player clinics for recreational, grassroots and Soccer for Life stream members.
- Support and deliver with the H&DSA Coach Development Manager a Female Mentorship/Leadership Program and a Youth Coaching Mentorship program.
- Establish partnerships with local University, Colleges, League One and Professional soccer organizations to create training events and opportunities for players with in the district.
- Any other duties as assigned by the General Manager, Director of Player & Coaching Development and the H&DSA Executive Board.

- Ontario Soccer Technical Director Certification or International Equivalent with a minimum National B Part 2 Coaching License (or equivalent).
